

Show Entry

The show will be held July 24-27, 2025 at Vilhelmsborg, Bedervej 101, 8320 Mårslet, Denmark. For questions before or after making an entry, please send an e-mail to phcdkentry@gmail.com

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

Arrival is possible from Tuesday July 22, 2025 from 3 PM. Opportunities to use warm-up arena and/or outside arena will be posted before the show. Show arena will be closed until Wednesday July 23, 2025 in the evening. Departure from show grounds and stalls must be Sunday when the show ends and no later than 8 PM.

IMPORTANT ENTRY DEADLINES

- **Early Bird Entry**
 - April 21 until May 7.
- **Standard Entry**
 - May 14 until June 22
- **Late Entry** (PHCDK reserves the right to reject late entries)
 - June 25 until July 13

EARLY BIRD REQUIREMENTS
















- Horse stall must be purchased
- PHCDK 2025 membership for horse owner and rider(s).
- For Novice Amateur and/or Amateur classes the riders must have a valid 2025 APHA Card or confirm the application by forwarded the APHA confirmation e-mail.
- Full entry payment before the deadline in the entry confirmation statement.

ENTRY PAYMENT

Bank details will be provided with the statement. Please do not make any bank transfers in advance. Entries that are not fully paid by the deadline in the statement, will be cancelled.

Price List (DKK)

During the Early Bird periode qualified entries receive a discount of **DKK 1500 per APHA weekend card** or **DKK 800** for entries in only PHCDK classes. Early Bird discount will be deducted from Entry Total. Late Entries will be an added a Late Entry fee of **DKK 500**.

* APHA PAY POINTS

APHA PAY POINTS are included in weekend card fee per horse for up to 8 classes per rider. Additional classes may be charged **DKK 100** per horse per class. APHA PAY POINTS is a new program from 2025. https://apha.com/about_apha/our-programs/paynt-points/

Change/Cancel Entry

When an entry is confirmed and paid, it is possible to make changes to classes, rider etc. Each change is a fee of DKK 50. Eg. adding an additional class to existing APHA weekend card. PHCDK reserves the right to reject entry modifications, and horse/rider replacements, after the Late Entry period and/or during the show.

HORSE OR RIDER REPLACEMENT

The fee of DKK 50 per change also applies to replacement of the horse OR rider for an existing entry. Please consider this option if the entered horse or rider is unable come to the show.

CANCEL AN ENTRY WITH A VALID VET CERTIFICATE

- **Early Bird entries**
 - 30% of the APHA weekend card/ Entry fees
 - PHCDK entry fees, Office charge and other fees not refundable
 - Stall 50 % refundable if vet certificate is dated and submitted before May 19
- **Standard entries**
 - 50% of the APHA weekend card/ Entry fees
 - PHCDK entry fees, Office charge and other fees not refundable
 - Stall not refundable
- **Late entries**
 - No refunds possible

STALL OWNERSHIP

When an entry is cancelled, with or without a vet certificate, the stall and bedding will be handed over to PHCDK and cannot be claimed or resold.

Stalls

Vilhelmsborg offers up to 84 permanent stalls in the main show barn just across the road from the arena. The availability of stalls beyond the permanent stalls is not guaranteed.

STALL ALLOCATIONS

Generally horses from the same Country/Trainer/Barn will be grouped together if possible. However, PHCDK cannot guarantee stall allocation next to/near other specific horses. The first version of the stall chart will be published before the show. PHCDK reserves the right to assign stalls and make changes as needed and publish an updated stall chart. Only the latest version of the stall chart is valid.

DONATE STALL DEPOSIT TO PHCDK

Support PHCDK by donating your stall deposit of DKK 300. When you are done showing, you can start loading and drive home - volunteers from the show team will clean your stall. Before the show PHCDK will share an online form for participants to let the show know if they want to donate their stall deposit. Participant who decide to request a refund, should note that all the bedding must be removed and the online form will require upload of an image of the clean stall.

TACK STALLS

Tack stalls include no bedding, it's an empty stall where you can store your show tack & clothing, training tack etc. and add a lock to the door. PHCDK takes no responsibility for missing items, so please consider a tack stall for high value tack to avoid bringing back and forth between stalls and trailer parking area. For safety reasons only limited amount of tack can be stored in front of each stall.

Classes and Schedule

PHCDK reserves the right to reschedule classes and publish an updated show schedule. Only the latest version of the show schedule is valid. The show schedule is dynamic and its the responsibility of each entry to be ready for entered classes. Time estimates are only guidelines.

APHA CLASSES

See show bill for complete list of APHA classes.

CANCELLATION OF CLASSES

APHA and PHCDK Classes with 0 or 1 entries when the Standard Entry period closes, will be removed from the show bill. Effected riders will receive a notice and the option to reselect.

ANNOUNCEMENT OF CLASS PLACINGS

In placed classes, the placings of each individual judge will be announced. In scored classes, only the overall placings will be announced, calculated as stated in the section about Danish Champion titles. Individual judge placings can be seen when the scoresheets are published.

PHCDK Classes

The PHCDK classes are for everyone – Youth, Amateur, and Open riders – and all horses, regardless of breed, age, or past show record. Our goal is to bring riders and horses of all levels together, offering everyone a chance to compete about prize money. Each PHCDK class is judged by 3 of the APHA approved judges and will be judged according to the current APHA Rulebook, except the above stated horse/rider requirements and that every horse can be shown in either snaffle bit and two hands or a bit and one-handed.

ENTRY FEE & PAYOUT

- The entry fee is DKK 450 per class
 - DKK 90 goes to PHCDK (30 DKK per judge)
 - DKK 360 goes directly into the payout purse for the class

PLACINGS

Only overall placings will be announced for PHCDK classes. Placings from all three judges will count in calculating the overall class placings. The calculation method is the same as used for Danish Champion titles in placed and scored classes.

PAYOUT

The payout in PHCDK Classes is 80 % of the entry fees for the class based on the actual number of entries (equal to stated on judge cards). Money Earners in PHCDK classes must submit their bank details for payouts before they leave the show. Payouts will be made by PHCDK during the week following the show.

Young Horse Cup

PHCDK Young Horse Cup is an Title and Trophy for the best Overall Young Horse at the show. The Young Horse Cup is based on three PHCDK Classes for young horses age 1-3 (birth year either 2022, 2023 or 2024). See the information about PHCDK Classes to understand the entry fee structure and how to 80% payout per class is split based on placings in the class.

HORSE BREEDS AND EXHIBITOR STATUS

Young Horse Cup classes are offered as PHCDK Classes so they are not limited to Paint Horses. In 2024, the PHCDK Young Horse Cup Winner, a Quarter horse gelding, received a payout of DKK 3934. Like the other PHCDK classes, there is also no limitations for the Exhibitor status to compete in PHCDK Young Horse Cup.

DISCIPLINES

Young Horse Cup disciplines are In-Hand Trail, Longe Line and Showmanship. The difficulty of patterns will be designed with young horses in mind.

PLACINGS

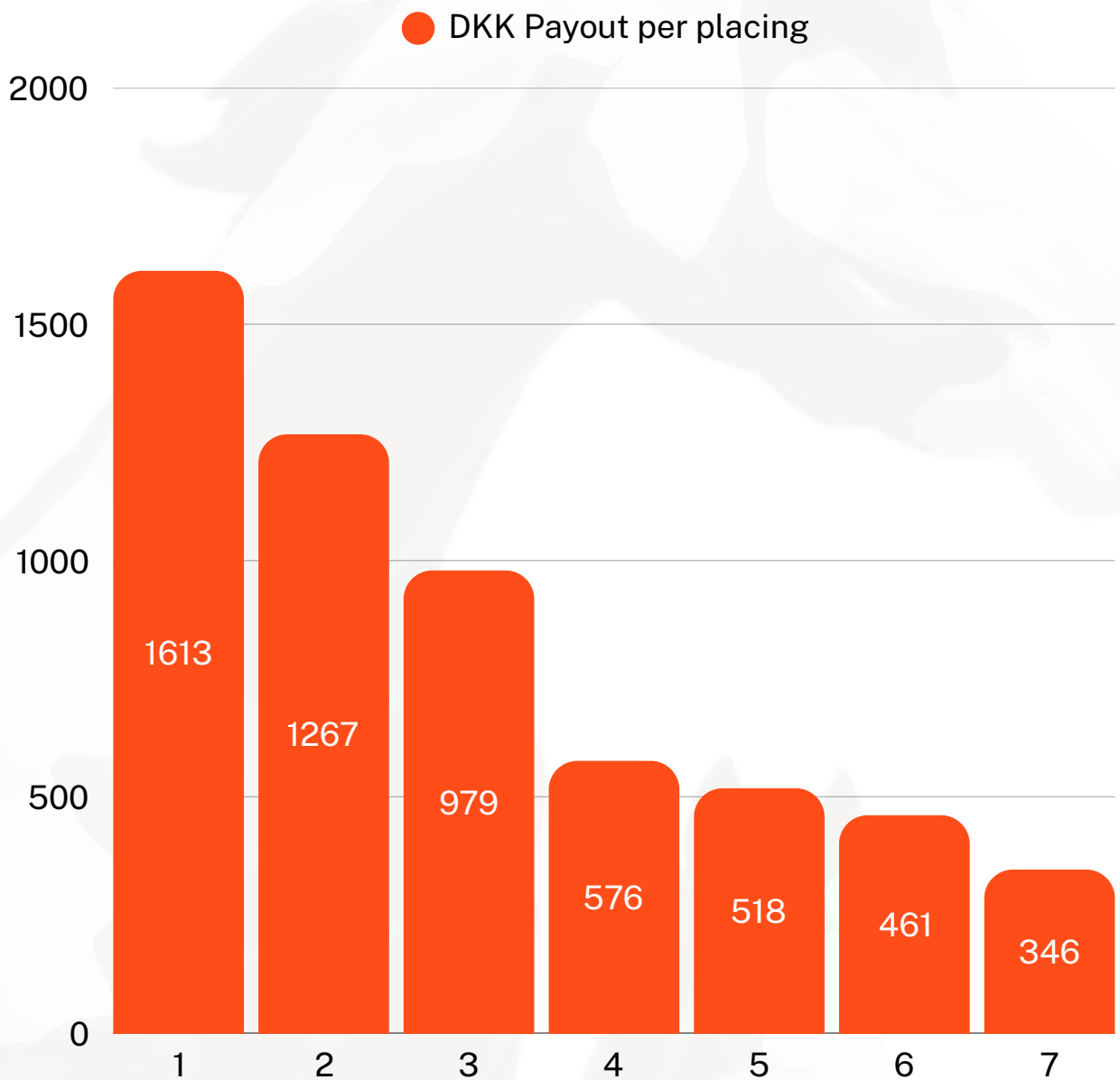
Only overall placings will be announced for each PHCDK classes. Each class is judged by 3 of the APHA approved judges and placings from all three judges will count in calculating the overall class placings. The calculation method is the same as the used for Danish Champion titles in scored classes.

TROPHY

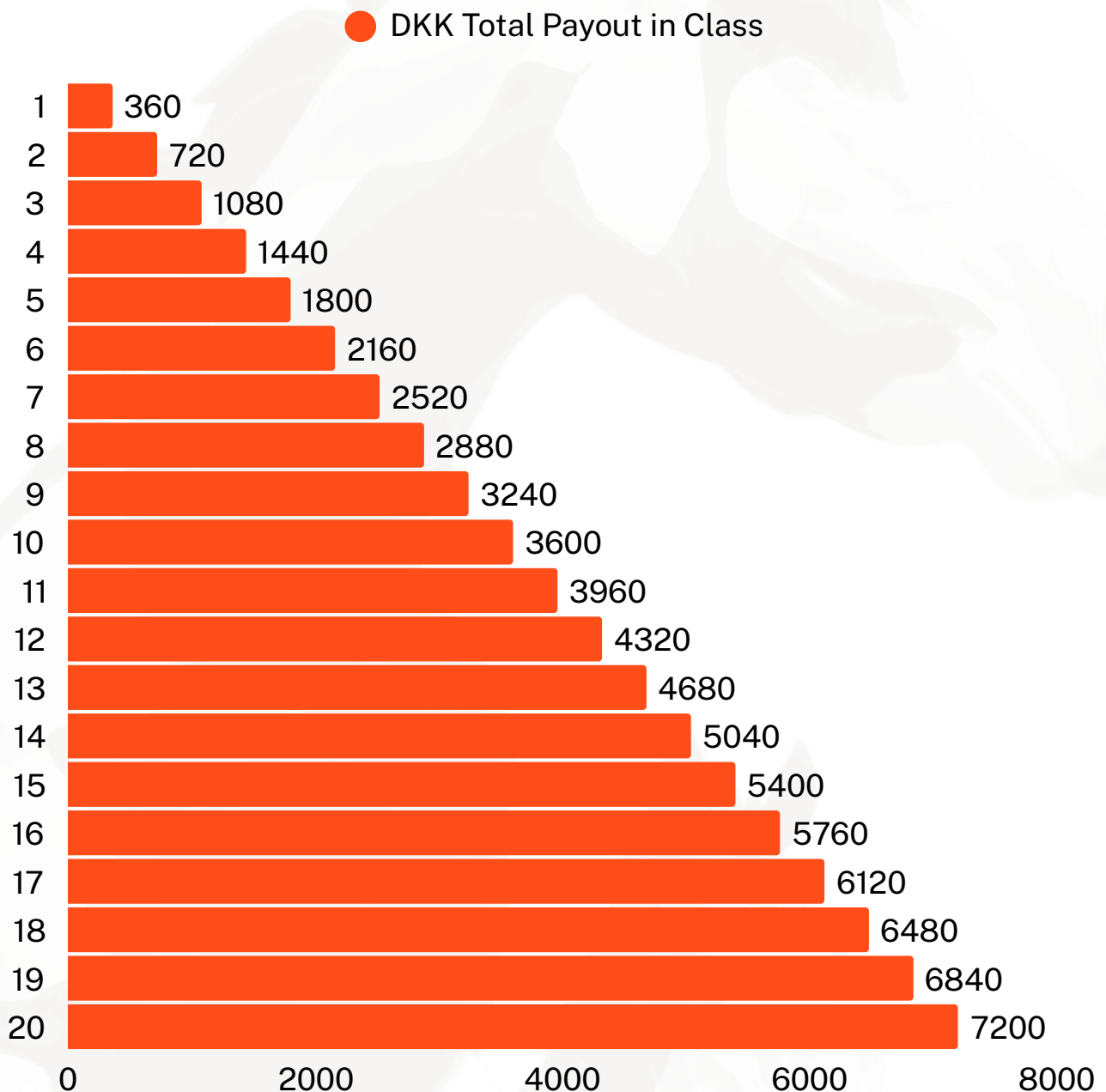
The overall placings for the PHCDK Young Horse Cup will be announced the last day of the show. The Winner receives a huge trophy sponsored by PHCDK.

Danish Champions

To qualify for Danish Champion titles, both horse owner and rider must be current members of PHCDK. International PHCDK Members qualify for medals equal to Danish PHCDK members. There will be Gold, Silver and Bronze medals in each class depending on the number of entries.

GOLD, SILVER AND BRONZE MEDALS

- **1 & 2 Entries:**
 - No titles will be awarded
- **3 & 4 Entries:**
 - Gold medal
- **5 Entries:**
 - Gold and Silver medal
- **6 & more Entries**
 - Gold, Silver and Bronze medal

PLACED CLASSES (NO SCORESHEET)

All four judges' placings will count to calculate the medal winners. The placings will be added up using the following point scale:

SCORED CLASSES

All four judges' scores will count in the calculations. The scores will be added up to a total score per horse. These total scores will be used to determine the medal winners in the class.

RESOLVING TIES

There will be a tie-breaker judge per day. Any ties calculating medal winners in both placed and scored classes will be resolved by using the placing/score for the tie-breaker judge.

Exhibitor Conduct

The 2025 APHA Rulebook applies from arriving at the showgrounds and until leaving the show, including good horsemanship and sportsmanship. The Show Team and Show Manager has the authority to enforce all rules stated in APHA Rulebook and the show announcement at any time before, during and after the show.

HORSE PASSPORT AND VACCINATIONS

The responsible party for each Show Entry must ensure:

- The horse has a valid passport and that the UELN passport number is submitted with the Show Entry. The passport of the horse should be available upon request the entire time the horse is at the showgrounds
- The horse is disease-free and vaccinated according to the general rules. Proof of vaccinations should be available upon request

COMMUNICATION FROM THE SHOW TEAM

The responsible party for each Show Entry must ensure to read and reply to e-mails from the Show Team about their Show Entry. General show information before, during and after the show will be made in the WhatsApp Show Group, scan the QR code below to join the group.



Vilhelmsborg

Located near Aarhus. The historic showgrounds of Vilhelmsborg - The National Equestrian Center - offer a 28x70 m. showarena and a 20x60 warm-up arena. The arenas are connected by a tunnel. There is also a huge outside arena.

Up to 84 permanent stalls are available in the main show barn just across the road from the arenas. The barn is divided into aisles with each entrance from the side of the building.

At Vilhelmsborg you can spend the entire show at the showgrounds Either bring your own RV/Camper or rent one of those available at the grounds to stay at the on-site camping area.
